- Team Registration Information Sheet with Manager's signature
- Completed Roster with player information and signatures
- Full payment

Fees:

The cost to participant in the league is \$210 per team, plus \$10 per non-resident player. For example, if you have a team of 10 with 2 of those players living outside of the Incorporated-Danville boundaries, your total team league fee will be \$230 (\$210 + \$10 +\$10). Please be advised that an additional fee will be charged for any non-resident additions to the roster after submission.

Non-resident fees are waived for teams sponsored by an Incorporated-Danville business. The league fees must be paid with a company check.

Residency Status Clarification:

To qualify as an all-resident team, ALL players on the roster must live within the Incorporated-Town of Danville boundaries. If you live in the 94506-zip code, please confirm your residency status at www.danvillepioneer.org.

Managers Meeting:

An option Managers Meeting is scheduled for Thursday, April 4 at 6:30pm. The Manager's Meeting will be held at the Town Meeting Hall (201 Front Street). While this meeting is not mandatory, Managers are encouraged to attend as important information and any changes are discusses at the meeting.
